Fundraising

A - Afternoon Tea: Host a delightful afternoon tea event where church members can come together to enjoy delicious treats and fellowship. Have your congregation pay a small entry fee and donate the proceeds.

B - Book Sale: Collect old books from church members and host a book sale, with all proceeds going towards *Care for Children*.

C - Craft Fair: Organize a craft fair at the church where church members and local artisans can showcase and sell their handmade crafts. Attendees can browse a variety of unique items with a portion of the proceeds going towards a charitable cause.

D - Dollar-a-Day Challenge: Encourage church members to participate in a Dollar-a-Day Challenge where they commit to donating one dollar for each day of a specified period such as the Christmas holidays.

E - Easter Egg Hunt: Organize a fun-filled Easter egg hunt for children in the community, with participants paying a small fee to join in.

F - Film Night: Host a movie night at the church and charge an entry fee, with all proceeds going towards *Care for Children*. This is a great opportunity to screen our documentary 'Children of Shanghai'. Feel free to use our discussion questions to encourage meaningful conversations.

G - Games Night: Plan a games night where church members can come together to play board games, card games, and more, with a portion of the proceeds going to *Care for Children*.

H - Head Shaving: Brave church members can volunteer to shave their heads in exchange for donations, with the event streamed online for extra fundraising potential.

I - International Food Festival: Celebrate the diversity of your church community by hosting an international food festival, with attendees paying to sample delicious dishes from around the world.

J - Jumble Sale: Gather used and vintage items from church members and host a jumble sale, with proceeds supporting *Care for Children*.

K - Karaoke Night: Invite church members to showcase their singing talents at a karaoke night fundraiser, with participants paying to perform their favourite songs.

L - Lent: Encourage church members to participate in Lent where they give up a luxury or indulgence for the duration of Lent and donate the money they would have spent to *Care for Children*.

M - Murder Mystery Dinner: Organize a thrilling murder mystery dinner event where attendees can solve a fictional crime while raising money for a *Care for Children*.

N - Non-uniform Day: Encourage students at the church's school to participate in a non-uniform day, with a donation required to wear casual clothes instead of the uniform.

O - Obstacle Course Challenge: Set up an obstacle course on the church grounds and invite participants to tackle the challenge for *Care for Children*.

P - Penalty Shootout: Host a football/soccer penalty shootout fundraiser. Participants pay to take shots on goal against a goalkeeper. You can charge per shot or for a set number of attempts. Offer prizes for top scorers.

Q - Quiz Night: Host a trivia quiz night at the church, with teams paying to participate and compete for prizes.

R - Read-a-thon: Encourage church members to participate in a read-a-thon fundraiser, with sponsors pledging donations for every book of the Bible read.

S - Sports Tournament: Organize a sports tournament, such as football, with teams paying to enter and compete for a charitable cause with proceeds going to *Care for Children*. This is a great way to not only raise funds, but a fun way to get active and bond as a community.

T - Talent Show: Showcase the talents of church members at a talent show fundraiser, with attendees paying to watch the performances.

U - Unity Walk: Organize a unity walk event where church members can come together to walk for *Care for Children*.

V - Vintage Clothes Sale: Have church members donate and sell their vintage clothing items. Display the clothes on racks or tables with price tags, and promote the event through social media, flyers, and church announcements. All proceeds from the sale can go towards supporting *Care for Children*.

W - Wash: Get your bucket out and organise a charity car wash. Have your congregation set up a car wash for the neighbourhood, and donate the proceeds to *Care for Children*.

X - X Marks the Spot: Organize a Treasure Hunt fundraiser for the Sunday School children and their families. Create a series of clues or a map leading participants to hidden treasures around the church grounds or a nearby park. Charge a small participation fee for each child to join the treasure hunt and offer prizes for the winners.

Y - Youth Night: Host a special youth night at your church and charge an entry fee at the door. Consider inviting youth groups from nearby churches to foster a sense community. Have some live music from your church band, and don't be afraid to get creative!

Z - Zumba Dance Party: Host a Zumba dance party fundraiser where attendees can groove to the music and get fit while supporting *Care for Children*.
